Husson Stock Index

Week Ended July 24, 2020

For the week ended July 24, 2020, the Husson Stock Index (HSI) finished the week up 0.68%, closing at 171.42. In comparison, the S&P 500 finished the week down 0.28%. Year-to-date, the HSI is down 0.75%, whereas the S&P 500 is down 0.08%.

Summary

Northeast Bancorp (NBN: NASDAQ) broke its nearly month-long trend of weekly declines, rising 5.05%, or \$0.73. NBN announced Tuesday a share repurchase program for up to \$10.2 million or about 7.3% of outstanding common stock (Northeast Bank, 2020). Share buy-backs by companies typically signal an undervalue in the stock from the company's metric and also increases short-term earnings per share, buy taking shares out of the market. This announcement accounted for a good portion of the company's gains for the week. It later had another gain on Friday when announcing its earnings call date of July 29th.

Another stock that recently experienced declines, yet moved in a positive direction this week is Bank of America Corporation (BAC: NYSE) gaining 4.87% or \$1.13. BAC had their earnings call Monday with mixed news from company officials resulting in a small increase.

CEO Brian Moyihan discussed an increase in reserves as new economic projections show recessionary economic activity well into 2022, suggesting the bank could experience higher credit losses. Moyihan did suggest spending will recover noting that while April spending was down by 26% compared to last April, June was nearly flat as many parts of the country are in the stages of

reopening their economies. The call emphasized their position being optimistic and their structure being resilient in the questionable "start-stop" and recessionary environment due to the pandemic (Bank of America, 2020). The company also announced on Wednesday a cash common stock dividend of \$0.18 per share. to be issued September 25th with a September 4th date of record. This dividend is in addition to their regular preferred stock dividend (Bank of America-Business Wire, 2020). Later in the week, Warren Buffet increased Berkshire Hathaway's already large stake in BAC to about 11% of the company, the largest of Berkshire's bank holdings (Narayanan, 2020). The purchases that took place across the week added up to over \$800 million (Chiglinsky, 2020).

Immucell Corp (ICCC: NASDAQ) faced the highest percentage decline in the HSI this week, down 6.04%. This is a change in direction compared to the 10.45% increase in the prior week.

The second highest decline was Rite Aid (RAD: NYSE) with a 4.37% decrease. The decrease in RAD stock happened fairly steadily across the week. The company announced the final results of a previously announced offer to exchange 6.125% Senior Notes due 2023 for 8% Senior Secured Notes 2026 and cash (Business Wire, 2020).

Overview

The HSI was developed by Marie Kenney, while a student at Husson University, in consultation with Associate Professor J. Douglas Wellington. The index is currently being tracked and analyzed by Husson student, Caitlin Cushman. The HSI tracks and analyzes the stocks of 29 companies that are considered to have an effect on the Maine economy. These companies are either based in Maine or have an influence on the Maine economy through employment or consumer

spending. This price-weighted index offers a numerical breakdown of Maine's economy. The analysis looks into the events of the week and finds the likely reasons the index went up or down. This index and analysis help provide a better understanding of Maine's economy as well as explain significant changes in stock prices of the companies that comprise the HSI.
