Husson Stock Index

Week Ended June 18, 2021

For the week ending June 18, 2021, the Husson Stock Index (HSI) finished the week at 228.65, down 2.42% from last week's close of 234.31. In comparison to the HSI, the S&P 500 finished the week at 4,166.45, down 1.91% from last week's close of 4,247.44. Comparing the HSI and S&P year-to-date, the HSI has increased 10.69% and the S&P has increased 10.93%.

Summary

The stock with the largest percentage change for the week was Bar Harbor Bankshares (BHB: NYSE), which decreased 12.49% or \$3.67. Carlton Getz, CFA wrote that BHB is overvalued due to a number of factors, including BHB's acquisition of Lake Sunapee Bank Group in 2017. Year-to-date, the stock has increased 13.81% or \$3.12.

The stock with the second-largest percentage change for the week was Penn National Gaming, Inc. (PENN: NASDAQ), which decreased 12.00% or \$10.06. Investor's Business Daily has indicated PENN is not currently a "buy", falling below certain key benchmarks. Year-to-date, the stock has decreased 14.56% or \$12.59.

Overview

The HSI was developed by Marie Kenney, while a student at Husson University, in consultation with Associate Professor J. Douglas Wellington. The HSI tracks and analyzes the stocks of 29 companies that are considered to have an effect on the Maine economy. These companies are either based in Maine or have an influence on the Maine economy through employment or consumer spending. This price-weighted index offers a numerical breakdown of

Maine's economy. The analysis looks into the events of the week and finds the likely reasons the index went up or down. This index and analysis help provide a better understanding of Maine's economy as well as explain significant changes in stock prices of the companies that comprise the HSI.
