What is Maine Media Camp?

MMC is a week-long introduction to careers in radio, video production, journalism, digital photography, webmedia, marketing communications and audio engineering. Over 20 professionals from the media will show you the essential workings of the over-the-air and behind-the-scene careers in communications. There are seminars where you can pick the brains of the presenters, workshops where you get your hands on gear and produce, and station tours that show what the industry is like on a day-to-day basis.

Who Can Attend?

Maine Media Camp is open to students entering their sophomore, junior or senior year in high school. For students considering a career in media communications, a week at Maine Media Camp will provide relevant information and a unique opportunity to get experience that will help guide you in your career goals.

What Facilities Will Campers Be Using?

Facilities include WHSN 89.3 FM (Bangor's award-winning Alternative radio station) and the Wildey Communication Center which houses TV/Video Production studios & editing suites, Sound Recording studios with live room and Digital Media Labs. Campers will also work in Hart Studio and the Gracie Theatre, also located on the Husson University campus

Where Do Campers Stay?

The accommodations are dormitories on the Husson University campus. The campus includes a dining commons complex, student lounges, swimming pool, tennis courts, and more.

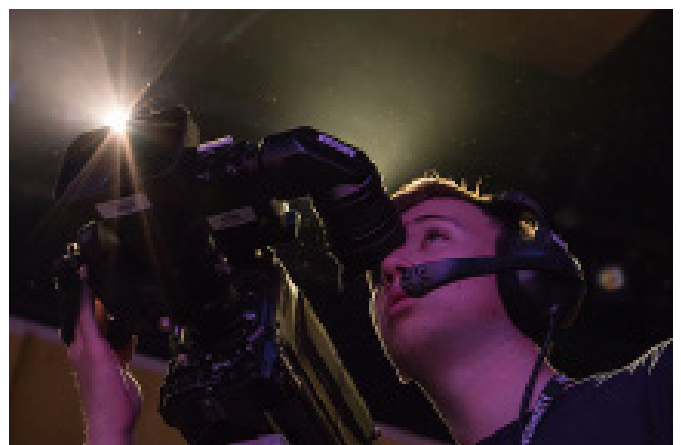
