Title IX Sexual Harassment



- Sexual Harassment
 - Quid Pro Quo Sexual Harassment
 - Hostile Environment unwelcomed conduct that is severe, pervasive and objectively offensive
 - Sexual Assault
 - Dating Violence
 - Domestic Violence
 - Stalking

- Being Developed by the Courts
 - Suicidal Ideations
 - Harm to Self and Others
- Your role –Report



Difficult Situations



- Offer Support
- Let Students Know of Your Obligation to report to the University
- Listen –No need to prompt or investigate
- Let them know of resources that are available
- Report matter to the University
