Attached alongside this letter is a copy of the report submitted by site review team members for the Council for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Educational Programs (CACREP), detailing their April 10-12, 2023 accreditation review of the Clinical Mental Health Counseling (M.S. degree) and School Counseling (M.S. degree) specialty areas housed in the College of Science and Humanities at Husson University. The team reviewed the specialty areas under the 2016 CACREP Standards.

The institution is allowed thirty (30) days in which to forward its response to the site review team's report. The Institutional Response should be submitted via CACREP's [online Report Submissions page](#) no later than **5 p.m. Eastern Time on June 5, 2023**. The next CACREP Board of Directors meeting is scheduled for July 6-8, 2023. The Board will review the specialty areas and make accreditation decisions at this meeting.

As the team's report does not specify any Standards as not met, the Institutional Response should provide acknowledgement of receipt of the report and any additional information or documentation the institution wishes to provide to the Board. The team's report does offer suggestions for the counseling program to consider. The institution may choose to respond to these suggestions in the Institutional Response but there is no requirement to do so.

Please be advised that in making accreditation decisions, the CACREP Board of Directors will use information from the institution's self-study (including any addenda), pertinent correspondence between the CACREP office and the program, the site review team's report, and the institution's response to the site review team's report. In addition, please be advised that according to Board policy, the institution has the right to withdraw any program from further review at any time during

the accreditation process prior to a decision by the Board, through written communication with the CACREP office.
