Candidates for a Bachelor of Science degree are required to complete a minimum of 120 semester hours maintaining a 2.0 overall cumulative grade point average and a 2.0 overall in their major courses. Transfer students must complete a minimum of thirty (30) credit hours at Husson University. At least fifteen (15) credits must be earned in Communications Technology courses.

\*In order to progress in the Video Production program a grade of C+ or higher must be achieved.

Depending upon credit allocation, students may need to complete an extra elective course to meet minimum 120 credit requirement.
