Candidates for a Bachelor of Science degree are required to complete a minimum of 120 semester hours maintaining a 2.0 overall cumulative grade point average and a 2.0 overall in their major courses. Students may need to complete 6 credits of HS 491 or an extra elective to meet minimum 120 credit requirements depending upon credit allocation. Transfer students must complete a minimum of thirty (30) credit hours at Husson University. At least fifteen (15) credits must be earned in Husson Health Care Studies courses.
