Student Email

All financial aid communication will be through the student's Husson provided email account. Returning student award letters are emailed to your Husson email account. All communication will be directed to the student.

Privacy and Security

As part of federal requirements, we may be requesting confidential information from you, such as Tax Returns and copies of W2s. In order to keep your personally identifiable information secure, you have the ability to upload your documents directly to us using your Student Portal. You can also securely fax your documents to our office at 207.992.4930.

Emailing such documents is not a secure submission method and will not be accepted.

Winter and Summer Session

If you will be taking winter or summer session classes please contact the Office of Financial Aid once you have registered for the classes. Please note to receive financial aid for summer classes, you must be taking at least 6 credit hours as an undergraduate, and 3 credit hours as a graduate student.

June 8, 2020 Priority Paperwork Deadline

Financial aid will not be disbursed to your student account until all required paperwork, including verification documentation, is received and processed. For your financial aid to be reflected on your June 15th billing statement, all documents listed on your financial aid offer letter must be received by June 8th. Please note that your financial aid is subject to change at any time due to a variety of factors.

Understanding Your Awards

- **Pell Grant and Federal Supplemental Opportunity Grant (FSEOG)** Federal grants offered to students based on financial need. Your financial need has been calculated based on the cost of attendance minus your expected family contribution (EFC) from your FAFSA.
- **State Grants** If you are offered a state grant, you will receive notification of this grant directly from your state of residence.
- **Husson Institutional Grants** These grants are offered to students based on financial need and vary from year to year. Students are not guaranteed to receive these funds every year they are enrolled. Graduate, Online, and Extended Learning students are not eligible.
- **On-Campus Residence Grant** You must reside on campus and have financial need to receive this grant. Should you decide to reside off campus, you must notify our office.
- **Federal Work-Study (FWS)** This is an eligibility to earn a bi-weekly paycheck based on the number of hours you work. Students who are not eligible for work-study may still apply for on-campus employment.

Tuition Payment Plan

Education expenses are easier to pay when spread over predictable, interest-free monthly payments. This option, offered in partnership with **Nelnet Campus Commerce** for a small fee, is an alternative to large annual or term payments and helps limit borrowing. Enrollment & Academic Standing

Generally, you must be enrolled at least half-time (6 credits per semester for undergraduates or 3 credits per semester for graduates) and matriculated in a degree program to be eligible for financial aid. A change in credit hours may cause a reduction in aid eligibility.

Most scholarships require a 2.5 GPA or higher to maintain eligibility.

Withdrawals

If you withdraw from school any time after the first day of classes, your financial aid will be adjusted according to federal guidelines. Withdrawal from a single course after the add-drop period will not result in an adjustment to your award as you will be billed the full cost of the class.

William D. Ford Direct Loan Master Promissory Note and Entrance Counseling

NEW STUDENTS ONLY, who are accepting Direct Loans offered on the Offer Letter

Every student new to Husson University must complete a **master promissory Note (MPN)** and **Entrance Counseling** regardless if they have borrowed loans before at another school.

To complete this process please follow the instructions below:

1. Go to www.studentaid.gov, and sign in using your FSA ID.
2. Click "Complete Counseling".
3. Under "Choose Loan Counseling Type" select "Entrance Counseling".
4. Select Husson University as the school for which you are completing counseling.
5. Click "Notify this School".
4. Click "I am completing entrance counseling to receive loans as an undergraduate student".
5. Once you complete the Entrance Counseling, PRINT the confirmation page for your records.
6. Click "Complete a Master Promissory Note" (MPN).
7. Click on Subsidized/Unsubsidized.
8. Fill in all Personal Information and School Information as requested.
9. PAY CLOSE ATTENTION TO THE DIRECTIONS IN THE GRAY BOX AT THE TOP OF THE PAGE when completing the references section of your MPN. Failure to provide valid references will result in a rejection of your MPN, and a delay in your loan funds.
10. You must read each section of the terms and conditions to continue
11. You must open and review the HTML version of the document. When you return back to original screen, enter your name at the bottom of the screen. Click Sign. Click Continue.

Undergraduates: \$612/credit hour

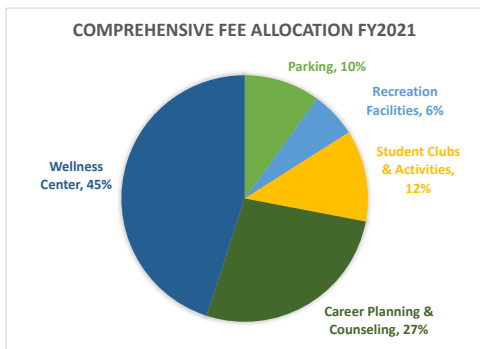
Graduate Business and Criminal Justice: \$516/credit hour

Graduate Nursing: \$642/credit hour

Occupational Therapy 3rd, 4th, and 5th year: \$710/credit hour

Physical Therapy 4th, 5th, and 6th year: \$711/credit hour

Doctor of Pharmacy: \$1072/credit hour



Comprehensive Fee: Students taking 9 credits or more will be charged a comprehensive fee of \$800/year. Students taking under 9 credits will be charged \$400/year.

Program Fees: Undergraduate: NESCom \$900/year; Nursing \$640/year Graduate: Counseling \$600/year; Nursing \$1,710/year; Occupational Therapy \$400/year; Pharmacy \$1,200/year; Physical Therapy \$520/year

Residence Halls: Students who live on campus will be charged between \$10,632^{+/} and \$13,101^{+/} per academic year depending on room type and meal plan.

Books: Husson University recommends that students budget \$575^{+/} per semester for books, though costs will vary
