Please follow these basic parking rules:

1. Avoid parking in a handicapped or visitor space if you are not handicapped or a visitor. (*Handicapped parkers are required to display a valid handicapped placard or plate.*)
2. Park in paved parking spaces only — not on lawn or mud.
3. Avoid parking in *fire lanes, No Parking Zones or on diagonal hash marks.*
